This includes selecting and leading your team, planning meetings, communicating with teachers, parents, and buddy pairs, and ensuring fun and success!</p>	<p>The Buddy Director role communicates with the buddies in the chapter to share program goals, ideas, and helps manage overall chapter success; this role is typically filled by a student with IDD.</p>	<p>How the chapter organizes the leadership is up to each individual school. We recommend identifying what is important to your chapter; make sure you have someone to share communication, track finances, promote events, and help keep things on track!</p>
