# You are now an official Best Buddy!

Buddy: a student or individual with an intellectual disability

Peer Buddy: a full time student

Buddy Pair: a buddy and a peer buddy matched in a one to one friendship based on similar interests.

Associate Member: a member of Best Buddies not paired in a one to one friendship, attends group events and helps out the chapter

Staff Advisor: a teacher at your school who oversees the club, they are the main contact for you to turn to

Chapter President: a student leader for your Best Buddies club, you can also turn to him/her with any questions
